

WHY FEMINISM


"Some people ask: **Why the word feminist?** Why not just say you are a believer in human rights, or something like that?"


GENDER VIOLENCE STATISTICS





cis-gendered : The opposite of transgendered, someone who is cisgendered has a gender identity that agrees with their societally recognized sex.





